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Q8 - What is your current overall GPA?



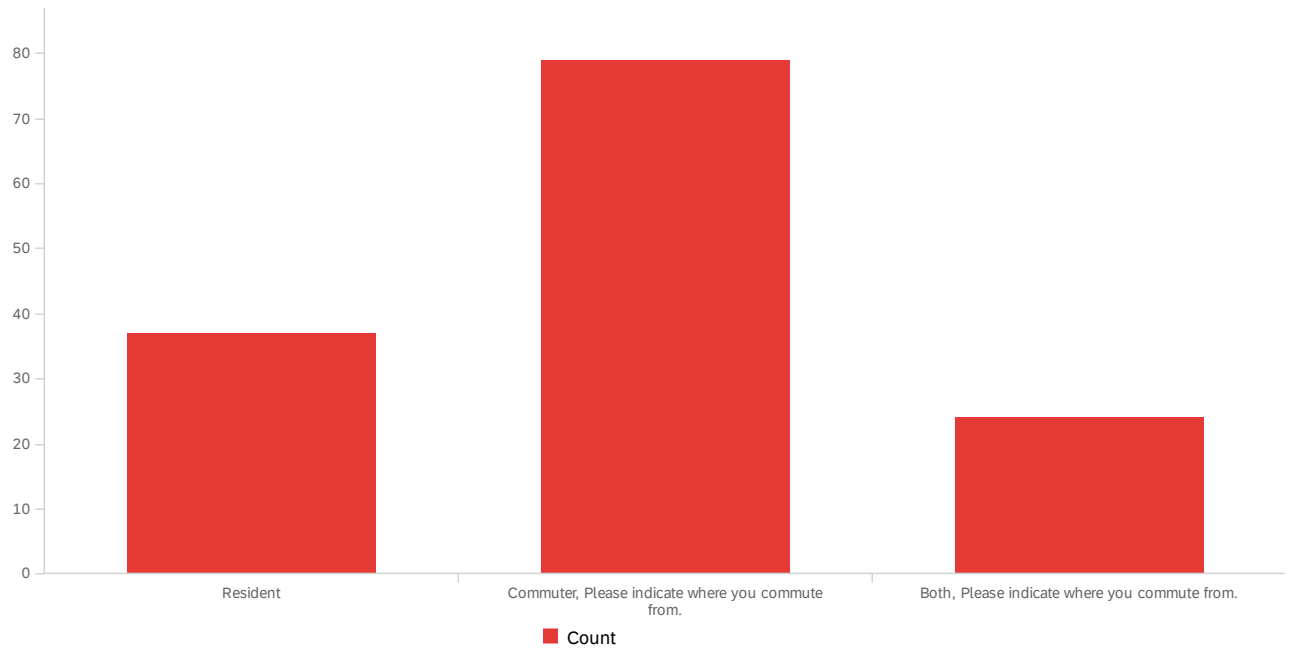

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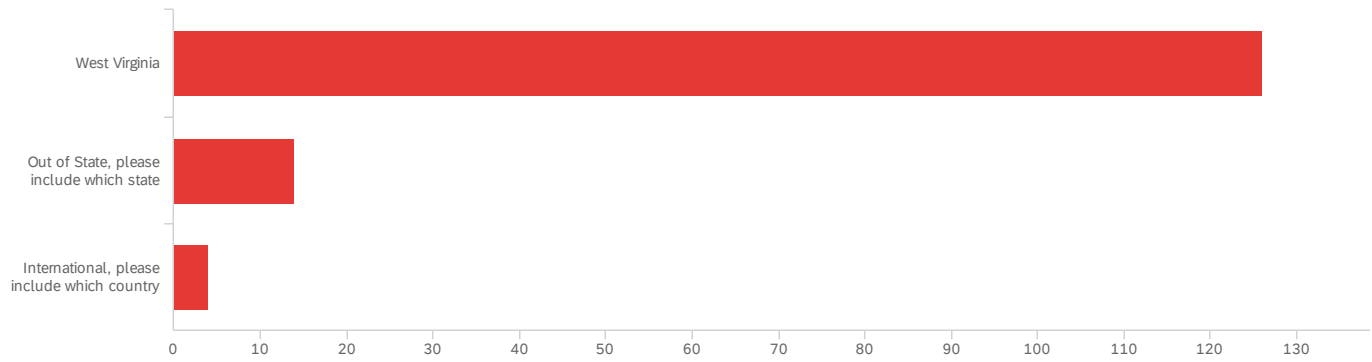

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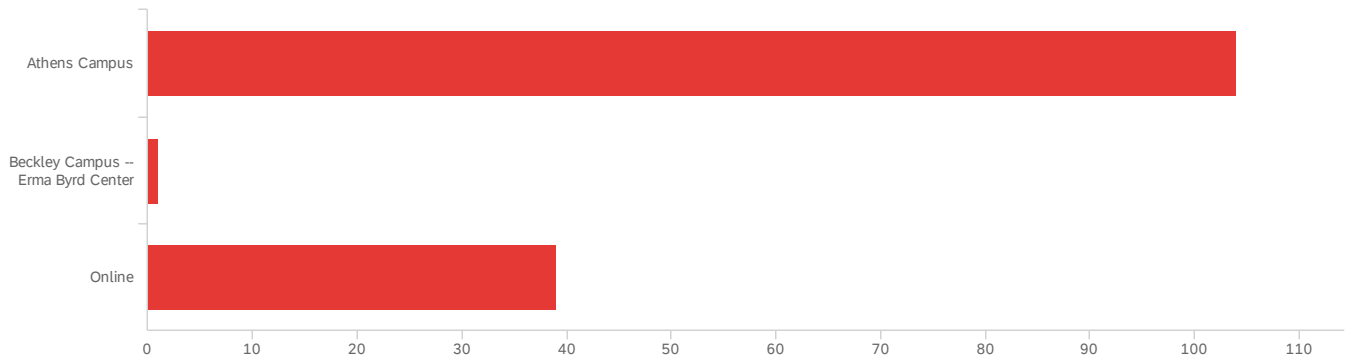
Q11 - What was your residence at time of admission to Concord University?

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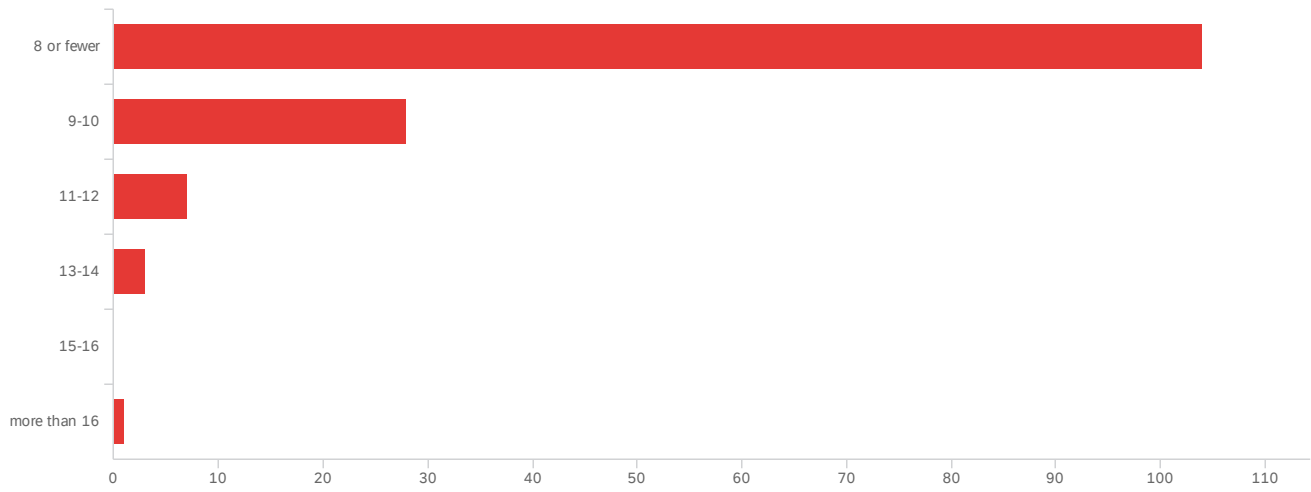
Q12 - Where did you complete the majority of your coursework?

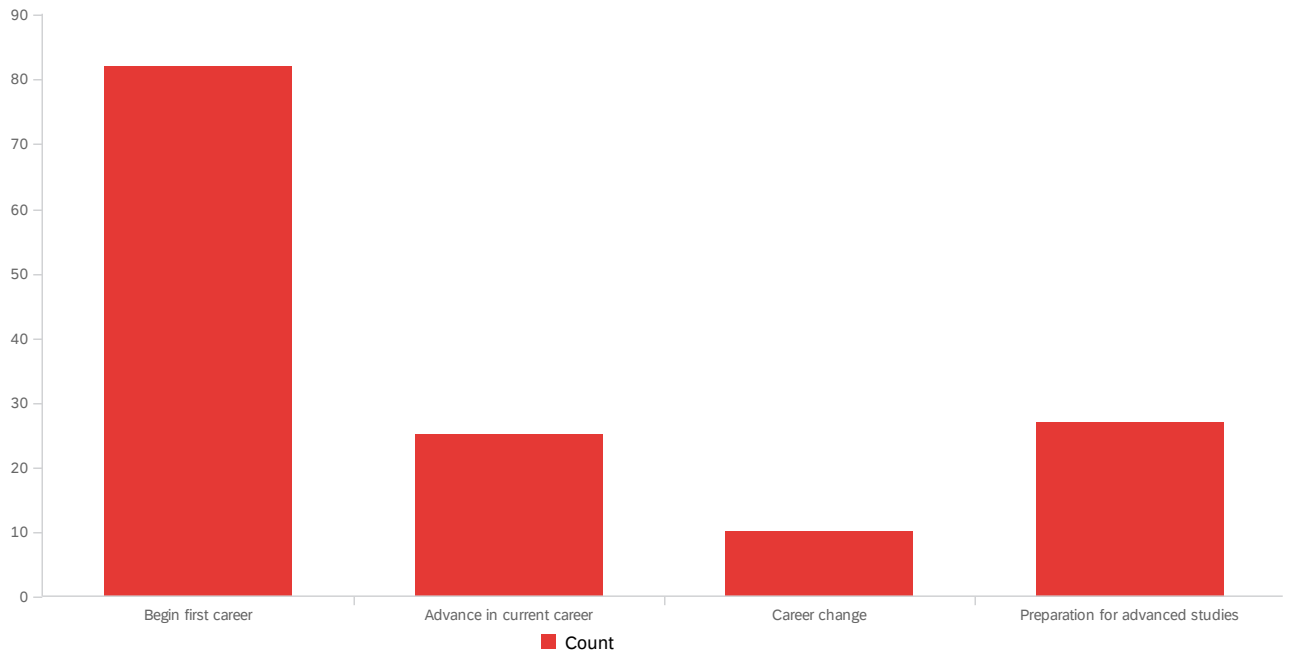
