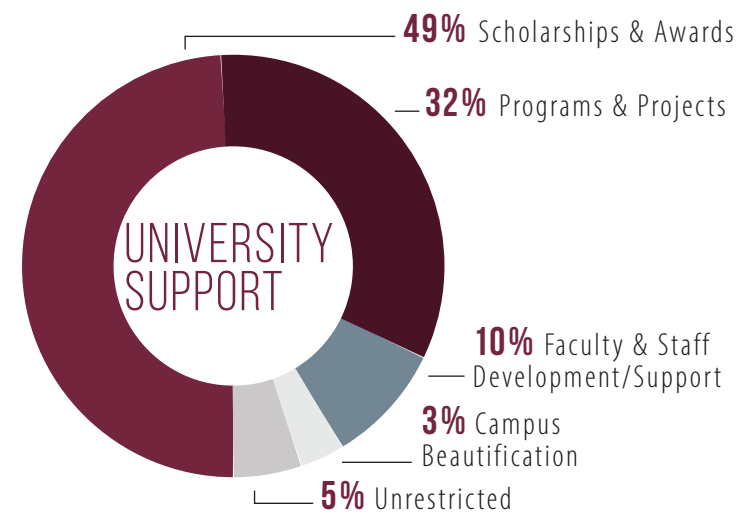

MISSION

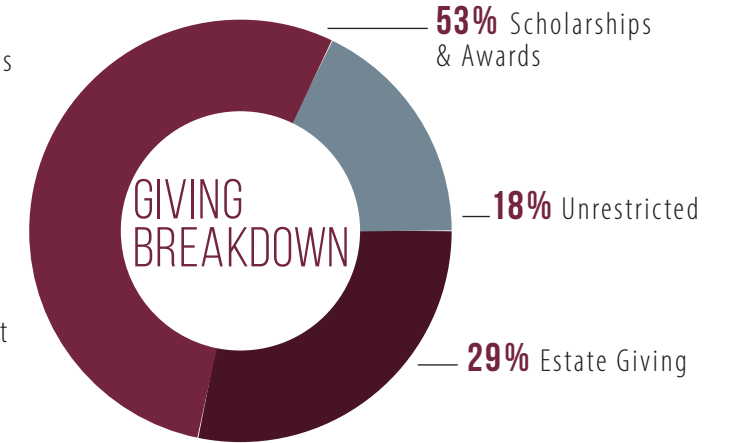

Pathways Scholarship

For the 2023 Academic Year, Concord University awarded 50 scholarships totaling \$2,000 each.

To date, 190 Concord students have been assisted financially with these scholarships over a 6-year period.

CU Food Pantry

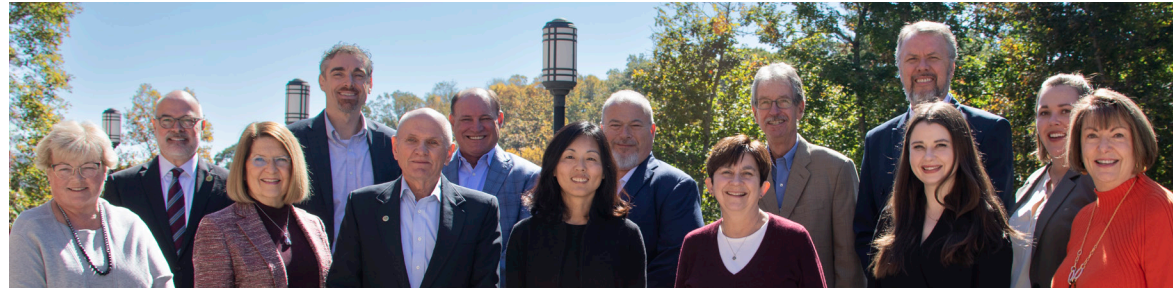

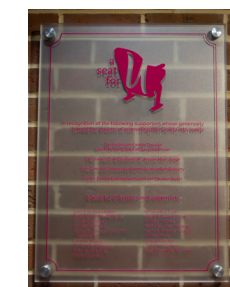
FACILITY UPGRADES

One of the areas where you can see Foundation support in action is through upgrades and improvements to some of our campus facilities.



Summer 2022 marked the conclusion of Phase One fundraising for renovations to the theatre spaces in the Alexander Fine Arts Center. Most of the composition of these spaces were original to the building (which opened in 1970) and were in serious need of some upgrades. Enough funding was secured through this Phase One effort to replace all of the seats in the main theatre, to update the ceiling and flooring, to re-finish the stage and to make some technology upgrades in the H.C. Paul Theatre. The theatre space was closed during the 2022-2023 academic year so that all of these updates could be made. We kicked off the 2023-2024 year with a re-opening of the theatre space, affectionately called “Intermission”. This event gave members of the Concord community and the local area the opportunity to see firsthand the improvements that had been made to the space.

It is through the generosity of donors such as Mr. Anderson, the Jessee’s and the CU Alumni Association that we were able to make this renovation a reality and we look forward to continuing to renovate some of the most beloved spaces on Concord’s campus through additional fundraising initiatives.



At the “Intermission” event we officially kicked off the second phase of fundraising for the theatre, “Act Two”. Gifts received during this campaign will go towards lighting, technical and stage support and new seating in the H.C. Paul Theatre.

Funding for the seats was secured through the A Seat for U campaign and through a grant from the Carter Family Foundation. A few gifts were secured for specific areas in the theatre and those areas were named in recognition of those donors. Those areas include:

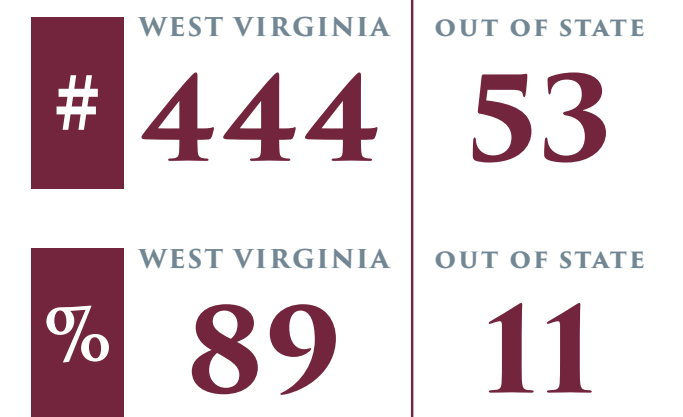
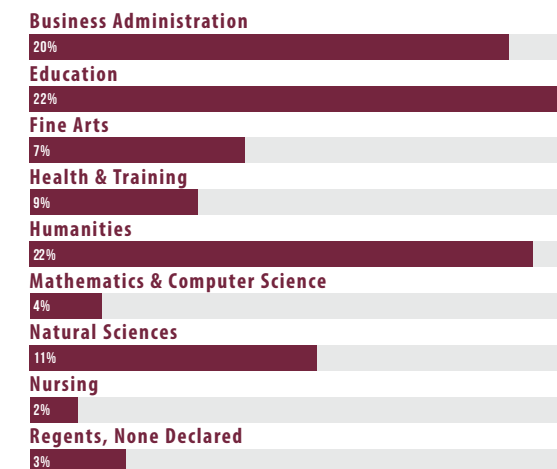
