Dr. M. L. Swarankar is a physician, a scholar, and a humanitarian; a man truly dedicated to a life of service based on the principles of Mahatma Gandhi. Dr. Swarankar founded the first recognized Medical College in the private sector of Rajasthan in 2000. Five hundred of the six hundred and fifty beds at that medical college are reserved free of charge for the poor and needy. In December 2009, Dr. Swarankar initiated a pilot project with the Medical College and Hospital that enabled four Concord University students and one Concord professor to participate in a week long international medical shadowing experience at the Mahatma Gandhi Medical Hospital in Jaipur, India.

For your humanitarian service, leadership and scholarship in medicine, Concord University confers upon you the degree of Doctor of Humanities, *honoris causa*.
