MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This agreement has been developed in the interest of maximizing higher education opportunity in Southern West Virginia through the cooperation of Bluefield State College and Concord University.

The purpose of this agreement is to permit students enrolled for 12 or more hours at either Bluefield State College or Concord University to take courses of their selection at the other college without additional charge.

A student enrolled for 12 or more credit hours on either campus will pay tuition and fees on the campus (considered to be his/home campus) but will not pay additional tuition and fees on the other campus. Such students holding valid parking permits on either campus will be afforded parking privileges on both campuses and library privileges on both campuses.

Either party may terminate this Memorandum of Understanding by written notice 30 days in advance of the effective date of termination.
