psychopathology, and assessment of substance abuse and other addictions. Human Growth and Development: At least 3 semester hours or 4.5 quarter hours. The integration of the psychological, sociological, and biological approaches within the life cycle. Examples are awareness of culture, gender, or human sexuality at developmental levels, human behavior (normal and abnormal), personality theory, and learning theory. Research and Evaluation: At least 3 semester hours or 4.5 quarter hours. Includes such areas as statistics or research design and development of research and demonstration proposals. Undergraduate Courses: Graduate programs accepting an undergraduate course(s) as meeting the course criteria in subsection 2b through 2f will be acceptable.
